

**INSTRUCTIONS TO ALBANY
MEDICAL CENTER'S CENTER FOR
LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT**

From the NYS Thruway: Take the New York State Thruway to Exit 23. Bear right off the exit (Exit 1). At the light, turn left onto Southern Blvd. (9W). Proceed for approximately one mile to Delaware Avenue. Turn right onto Delaware Avenue, approximately 1/4 mile turn left onto St. James Place. At the light at the bottom of the hill, turn right onto Hackett Blvd. The Center for Learning and Development will be on your right, directly across from St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

From the North: Take the Northway (I-87) to I-90 East. Exit at I-787 South (Albany). Exit at Madison Avenue (Exit 3B). Proceed on Madison Avenue, turn left onto Delaware. Take a right onto Holland Ave. At the next light, take a left onto Hackett Blvd. The Center for Learning and Development is on your left, directly across from St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

From the East or West: Exit I-787 at Exit 3B (Madison Avenue). Proceed on Madison Avenue, turn left onto Delaware. Take a right onto Holland Ave. At the next light, take a left onto Hackett Blvd. The Center for Learning and Development is on your left, directly across from St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

PARKING INFORMATION

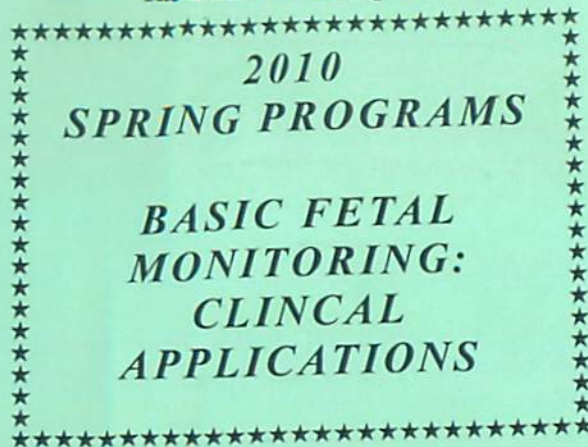

The purpose of this activity is to bring up-to-date information on Basic Fetal Monitoring to practicing registered nurses.
